

Mr. Markey, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to amend Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, Frederick county;

Mr. Malone, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections 156, 157, 158, 159 and 160, of Article 19, of the Code of Public Local Laws for Somerset county, and substitute the following, &c.;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Valliant, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to repeal the second section of the sixth Article of the Code of Public General Laws entitled "apprentices," relating to appeal, by parties supposing themselves aggrieved by the acting of the Orphans' courts from the decisions of said court, to the Circuit court of the county or to the Superior court of Baltimore city, and to re-enact the same with amendments thereto;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Anderson, from a Select committee, reported with amendment the bill entitled, an Act to make valid the official acts of the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown;

Which was taken up for consideration on its third reading.

Mr. Anderson submitted the following amendment:

Strike out the word "March" in 8th line of 1st section and insert the word "May;"

Which was decided in the affirmative.
