

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED:

Amend by adding the following section :

"Section 3. And be it enacted, That the pay herein provided for the policemen and officers of police aforesaid, shall continue only until the first day of April, 1867, and that from and after said day the pay of said policemen and detective policemen and officers of police, shall be the same as now provided by law."

Amend by striking out the word and figure "section 3" in the first line of section 3, and inserting in lieu thereof the word and figure "section 4."
