

Said bill was then returned to the Senate.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following Senate bills:

A bill entitled, a further supplement to an Act entitled, an Act to Incorporate Companies, to make several Turnpike Roads through Baltimore county, and for other purposes;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Baltimore county delegation.

A bill entitled, an Act to Incorporate the Empire Coal Company, of Allegany county;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled an Act appropriating a sum of money for services rendered the State by Daniel M. Moore and Job Haines, in the adjustment and payment of claims for bounty to Volunteers, under the Acts of 1864;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Claims.

A bill entitled, an Act to amend Article 26, of the Public General Laws of this State, relating to Corporations, by adding thereto certain additional sections, providing for the formation of corporations, in the business of obtaining oil by boring or otherwise, on and upon lands lying within the State, or beyond the limits thereof;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Corporations;

The Senate bill, entitled an Act to incorporate the Potapsco Copper Smelting and Manufacturing Company,

Was taken up for consideration on its third reading.

Mr. Jones submitted the following amendment:

Amend section 9 by striking out "Legislature" in the 1st line, and inserting "General Assembly;"

Which was decided in the affirmative.

The bill having been read the third time was passed by yeas and nays, as follow:
