R E P O R T :

To the Honorable,

The General Assembly of Maryland:

The Committee of Ways and Means, of the House of Delegates, and the Committee of Finance of the Senate, of the session of 1864 respectfully report that under the provisions of the Joint Resolution, of March 10th, 1864, No. 11, they went to the city of Annapolis, on second day of May, A. D. 1864, and at the office of the Treasurer of Maryland, proceeded to examine, count, and burn the bonds and certificates for Stocks of the State, purchased or obtained by the Treasurer, and that the said bonds and certificates for Stock so examined, counted and burned, were as follows: One hundred and thirty-two thousand two hundred and forty one dollars and forty-eight cents of Stocks of the State of Maryland, purchased for and in augmentation of the sinking fund, from 30th September, 1861, to 31st of December, 1861, by Sprigg Harwood, the late Treasurer of the State, (\$132,241 48.)

And four hundred and seventy-five thousand, five hundred and eighty-seven dollars and seventeen cents (\$475,587 17,) purchased for and in augmentation of the sinking fund, from February 3d, 1862, to January 1st, 1864, by Robert Fowler, Treasurer of the State.
