

On motion of Mr. Poteet,

Leave was granted a Select committee already appointed to report a bill providing for the placing of Statues of distinguished Marylanders to be placed in the Capitol at Washington.

On motion of Mr. Tarr,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the United States Fire Insurance company of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Shaw,

Leave was granted the Carroll county delegation to introduce a bill to provide for the transcribing of judgment docket No. 4, of the Circuit Court for Carroll county.

On motion of Mr. Darling,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the United States Central Insurance company.

On motion of Mr. Soper,

Leave was granted the committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled, an Act supplementary to an Act making appropriations for the support of the Government for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-six.

On motion of Mr. Anderson,

Leave was granted the Washington county delegation, to introduce a bill authorizing the County Commissioners of Washington county to pay a part of the liabilities incurred by the corporate authorities of Hagerstown in the Summer of 1864, for the ransom of said town from destruction by the rebels.

Which was read the first time and recommitted to the committee on Ways and Means.

Which was read the first time and recommitted to the committee on the Judiciary.
