Mr. Pennington, from the committee on Public Records, reported favorably the following bills :

A bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 29 of Article 5 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Appeals, relating to the preparation and preservation of the record of cases ;

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections 40 and 55, and to amend and re-enact section 55 of Article 18 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, "Clerks of Courts;"

Which were read the first time.

Mr. Soper, from the committee on Ways and Means, reported favorably, the following Senate bills :

A bill entitled, an Act to enable any bank of this State to become an association for the purpose of banking under the laws of the United States ;

A bill entitled an Act for the relief of George Washington McAtee, of Washington county, a deaf mute ;

Which were read the second time.

A bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 2, of the 81st article, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to revenue and taxes ;

A bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 2 of article 33 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the education of the deaf and dumb ;

A bill entitled, an Act to amend an Act passed at the January session, 1864, chapter 137, entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 25, of the 38th article, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, "Fees of Officers," and relating to the fees of Notaries Public ;

A bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money annually to the Childrens' Aid Society ;
