

A bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to Saint Vincent's Infant Asylum of the city of Baltimore ;

A bill entitled, an Act for the relief of Mary Poteet, by extending her time of instruction in the Maryland Institution for the instruction of the Blind,

Which were read the first time.

Also, reported back to the House, the leave to report a bill entitled, an Act to pay F. Sasscer, clerk of the Circuit Court, for Prince George's county, a certain claim against the State; with the recommendation that it be referred to the committee on Claims;
