A bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay J. E. & G. Munroe, Hayward, Bartlett & Co., and Frederick Sasscer, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county;

Which were read the first time.

Mr. Rider, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to legalize and make valid the official acts of the Corporate Commissioners of Salisbury, in Somerset and Worcester counties;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Hynes, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to amend sections 10, 11 and 15 of Article 84, of the Code of Public General Laws relating to Schools;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Pennington, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to provide for the weighing and measuring of grain in Baltimore city;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Angel, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to provide for substantial out-side and division fences;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Lee, of Queen Anne's, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Crumpton and Long Marsh Turnpike road company;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Poteet, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Gwynn's Falls Railroad company;

Which was read the first time.

Also, Senate bill entitled, a further supplement to an Act entitled, an Act to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county and for other purposes;

Which was read the second time.
