

Public Local Laws, entitled, Anne Arundel County, relating to the city of Annapolis, and to re-enact the same with amendments,

And recommended that it be referred to the Anne Arundel county delegation.

The report was accepted.

Mr. Kirk, from the Committee on Inspections, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an Act to Repeal section 564 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the City of Baltimore, relating to the compensation of Wood Corders and Inspectors in said city, by repealing said section and enacting the following, in lieu thereof:

Which was read the first time.

The bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of James Pritchard, Paul Martin, Sisco & Bro., R. J. Gittings, McDowell, Robinson & Co.;

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.

Mr. Rinehart submitted the following amendment:

Section 1, line 9, after the word "dollars" add as "compensation in full ;"

Which was decided in the affirmative.

The bill having been read the second time, was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Leave was granted the Cecil county delegation to introduce a bill to secure the records of patriotism of Soldiers and Sailors of Maryland dying in the service of the United States, and statistics of orphanage resulting from said deaths.

The bill entitled, an Act to authorize James A. Bond, Administrator of Thomas J. Hutchins, late Sheriff of Calvert county, to collect the fees due the said Hutchins,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 413 of Article 4 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Hay and Straw, and to re-enact the same with an amendment,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to Incorporate the Deep Creek Coal, Coal Oil, Lumber and Fire Brick Company of Allegany county,
