Said bill was then returned to the Senate.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following Senate bills:

A bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Coal, Iron and Oil Company of Allegany county;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, an Act to enable qualified voters of this State in the military service of the United States, to exercise the right of suffrage, etc.;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled, an Act appointing commissioners to construct a causeway connecting the bridge over the Patuxent river, near the village of Quenn Anne, in Prince George's county, with the main land in Anne Arndel county;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Prince George's and Anne Arundel county delegations.

A bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact sections 33, 34, 35, 38 and 39, of Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, revenue and taxes;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal the charter of the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Greensborough, Caroline county;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 9 and section 51, of Article 18, of Public General Laws relating to clerks generally;
