Mr. Anderson, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported favorably the following Senate bills :

A bill entitled, an Act to alter and change the name of Robert McEldowney, of Baltimore city, to that of Robert Levering.

A bill entitled, an Act to authorize Chauncey Brooks, Zenos Barnum, Alexander Murdoch, William Devries and Johns Hopkins to sell certain lands in Baltimore city;

A bill entitled, an Act to enable qualified voters of this State in the military service of the United States to exercise the right of suffrage, &c.;

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 4, Article 60 of Public General Laws, and to re-enact the same with amendments;

A bill entitled, an Act to add to Article 18 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Clerks of Courts, an additional section relating to the clerks of the Court of Common Pleas;

Which were read the second time.

Mr. Jones, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably the following Senate bills :

A bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 2 and 9 of chapter 24, of the laws of 1835, authorizing the building of a bridge over Gwynn's Falls, and to enact a substitute therefor;

A supplement to an Act entitled, an Act to incorporate the American Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore;

A bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the McHenry Oil Company;

A bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Coal, Iron and Oil Company of Allegany county;

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal the charter of the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Greensborough, Caroline county;
