

A bill entitled, a further supplement to an Act entitled, an Act to incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Cecil county;

Which were read the second time.

The bill entitled, an Act to repeal and re-enact sections 5, 26, 27 and 45 of an Act passed January session, 1864, chapter 346, entitled an Act to amend Article 4 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the leasing of the State Tobacco Warehouses, and the Inspection of Tobacco,

Was taken up for consideration, on its second reading.

Mr. Frazier submitted the following amendment:

Amend by striking out all between the words "twenty-seven" and "of," in line 2, section one, and insert in the same line and section, between the words "twenty-six" and "twenty-seven" the word "and;"

Which was decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Frazier submitted the following amendment:

Amend section 1, by striking out the word "thirteen," in line 16, and inserting "twelve," and in lines 17 and 18, the words "one thousand" and inserting "nine hundred;"

Which was decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Valliant submitted the following amendment:

Amend the first section by striking out all after line "44;"

Which was decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Frazier submitted the following amendment:

Amend by striking out "section 2;"

Which was decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Williams submitted the following amendment:

Sec. 2. Be it enacted, The owner of each hogshead of tobacco shall be allowed by the purchaser two dollars for each cask or hogshead in which the tobacco is packed, which sum of two dollars shall be paid to the grower or his agent before the tobacco is removed from the warehouse;

Which was decided in the negative.

Mr. Williams submitted the following amendment:

Section 2. Be it enacted, That the owner of each hogshead shall be entitled to receive for the cask or hogshead in which the tobacco is packed, the sum of one dollar and ninety cents,
