

which sum shall be paid to the grower or agent before the same is removed from the warehouse ;

Which was decided in the affirmative.

The bill having been read the second time was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to make valid an order passed by the Commissioners of Frederick county, Maryland, appropriating money to pay volunteers, drafted men and men furnishing representative substitutes, to fill the quota of said county in the call of the President of the United States for 500,000 men, and to authorize the Commissioners of said county to levy a tax upon the assessable property of certain districts in said county, to raise money so appropriated,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Lusby,

The rules were suspended, and the House took up for consideration the bill entitled, an Act appropriating the interest to be received from the sale of the scrip donated by the United States to the State of Maryland for the benefit of agriculture, by the Act of Congress approved 2d session, 1864, and to amend the charter of the Maryland Agricultural College, by adding additional members to the Board of Trustees ;
