

Mr. Markey, from a Select committee, reported back to the House, with amendments, the bill entitled, an Act to amend Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, "Frederick county;

Which was taken up for consideration on its second reading.

Mr. Markey submitted the following amendments :

Section 1, line 23, strike out the words "and required."

Line 32, strike out all after the word "some" down to the end of line 38.

Section 2, line 42, strike out the words "and required;"

Which were decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Markey submitted the following amendment :

Insert the following as an additional section :

Section 3. And be it further enacted, That the the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick be and they are hereby authorized to issue bonds maturing thirty years after the date thereof, and payable at the option of said Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council at any time after ten years from the date thereof bearing interest payable semi-annually at the rate of six per centum per annum, to an amount not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and shall be authorized to negotiate for the sale of said bonds at a sum not less than the par value thereof; and to apply the proceeds thereof to paying the Frederick county bank, Central Bank of Frederick, the Farmers and Mechanics Bank of Frederick county, the Fredericktown Savings Institution, and the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick, in the proportions advanced by said banking institutions respectively, towards paying said sum of two hundred thousand dollars;

Which was decided in the affirmative.

The bill was read the second time, by special order the third time, and passed by yeas and nays as follow:
