

of Article eighty-one, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled Revenue and Taxes;

A bill entitled, an Act to amend the Act passed on the 10th day of March, 1862, chapter 251, conferring certain powers on the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, in relation to levying and collecting taxes, for the purpose of defraying the the expenses of the municipal government, so as more clearly to exempt certain property from taxation;

Which were read the second time.

Mr. Miller, of Anne Arundel, moved to suspend the rules to give the said bill a third reading.

Which was decided in the negative.

Mr. Soper, from the committee on Ways and Means, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 106 of Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled Revenue and Taxes, and relating to the tax on executors and administrators commissions;

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Jones, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably the Senate bill entitled, a Act to Incorporate the Pocomoke Navigation Company;

Which was read the second time.

Also, reported back House bill entitled, an Act to amend the charter of the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Company entitled, a further supplement to the Act of 1815, chapter 48, passed December third, 1816;

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Cook, from the committee on Claims, reported favorably Senate bill entitled, an Act appropriating a sum of money for services rendered the State by Daniel M. Moore and Job Haines, in the adjustment and payment of claims for Bounty to Volunteers, under the Act of 1864;

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Anderson, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported with amendment the bill entitled, an Act to repeal section one hundred and eighty-five of Article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Talbot county, and to enact a new section in lieu thereof;

Which was taken up for consideration on its second reading.
