Mr. Buhrman submitted the following amendment:

Provided this Act shall not apply to Frederick, Carroll, Dorchester, St. Mary's, Prince George's, Somerset, Queen Anne's, Calvert and Howard counties;

Which was decided in the affirmative.

The bill having been read the second time, was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
