A bill entitled, an Act to provide for the payment of the State's proportion of the expenses incurred in burying the dead and enclosing and ornamenting the Soldiers National Cemetery, at Gettysburg;

A bill entitled, an Act to authorize the Commissioners of Kent county to levy a certain sum of money upon the taxable property of said county, for the improvement of the navigation of Fairlee Creek, in said county.

A bill entitled, an Act to empower the Commissioners of Kent county to charge wharfage for the use of the county wharf situated on Gray's Inn Creek, in Kent county.

Endorsed "passed by yeas and nays."

A bill entitled, an Act repealing certain sections of the 29th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to special Judges, and enacting other sections in lieu thereof;

Endorsed "passed by yeas and nays with proposed amend-ments."
