A bill entitled, an Act to regulate and make uniform the fees of Constables;

By striking out in section 2d, line 13, the words "fifty cents," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "seventy-five cents;"

By striking out in section 2d, line 18, the words "forty cents," and inserting in lieu thereof "forty-five cents;"

By striking out in section 2d, line 19, the words "fifteen cents," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "twenty-five cents;"

By striking out in section 2d, line 23, the words "forty cents," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "fifty cents;"

Amend further, by adding the following as section three:

Section 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and shall continue in force until the first day of April, 1867, from and after which last mentioned date, this Act shall be null and void, and of no effect whatever;
