Mr. Kirk, from the committee on Inspections, reported with amendments, the bill entitled, an act for the Inspection and and Guaging of Petroleum or Coal Oil, in the city of Baltimore;

Which was taken up for consideration on its second reading.

Mr. Kirk submitted the following amendment:

Amend 1st section, line 8th, by striking out "one cent" and inserting "half cent;"

Mr. Cook submitted the following amendment to the amendment:

Strike out "one-half" and insert "one-fourth cent;"

Which was decided in the affirmative.

The amendment as amended was then adopted.

Mr. Kirk submitted the following amendment:

Strike out the second section and insert the following, as section 2:

Section 2. Be it enacted, That the Governor shall, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, appoint one or more suitable and competent persons, as Inspectors and Guagers of Petroleum or Coal Oil, for the city of Baltimore, who shall take the oath prescribed by the constitution of the State, and the further oath to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of his said office. The duty of said Inspectors and Guagers shall be to inspect and guage all Petroleum or Coal Oil brought to said city, for sale or re-shipment. While inspecting such Petroleum or Coal Oil, the said Inspector shall use the proper means to ascertain if such Petroleum or Coal Oil has, introduced into it, benzine, benzole, or any other inflammable substance, and upon finding any such inflammma-
