

The House reconsidered the vote by which the bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections 293, 294, 295, 296, 297, 298, 299, 300, 301, 302, 303, 304, 305, 306, 307, 308, 309, 310, 311, 312, 313, 314, 315, 316, 317, 318, 319, 320, 321, 322, 323, 324, 325, 326, 327, 328 and 329 of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the city of Baltimore, entitled, "Fish," and also, the Act of 1864, chapter 269, relating to the same, and to re-enact other sections in lieu thereof,

Was rejected for want of a constitutional majority.

The bill was then passed by yeas and nays as follow :
