A bill entitled, an Act appropriating the interest to be received from the sale of the scrip donated by the United States to the State of Maryland for the benefit of agriculture, by the act of Congress, approved 2d session, 1864; and to amend the charter of the Maryland Agricultural College, by adding additional members to the Board of Trustees,

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments."

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED:

In line 2 of section 2, after the words "this act," strike out all down to instruction, and insert "the State Board of Education."

"Provided, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to prohibit or preclude the General Assembly, at any time hereafter, from making any other disposition of said funds, not inconsistent with the act of Congross making said donation."
