Said bill was then sent to the Senate.

Mr. Miller, of Washington, from a Select committee, reported favorably the bill entitled, an Act to amend the 13th section of the Act incorporating a company to make a Turnpike Road from Williamsport to Hagerstown, passed March 2d, 1833, chapter 125;

Which was read the second time.

The bill entitled, an Act to protect Terrapins in the waters of Queen Anne's county, and to regulate the taking of the same,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to make valid the acts of the Burgess and Commissioners of Middletown, Frederick county, Maryland, in levying a tax to pay the requisition made by General Early upon the citizens of said town in July, 1864, and to authorize the collection of the same,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, a supplement to an Act entitled, an Act to incorporate a company to make a Turnpike Road from Hagerstown in Washington county to the Pennsylvania line, passed December session 1846, chapter 333,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was recommitted to the Washington county delegation.

The bill entitled, an Act to provide for the recording of deeds neglected to be recorded according to law,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.
