The bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to refund Small and Strahm, Joseph Logsden, John V. Lowe, John Callen and Levi T. Hyat, moneys overpaid as per certificate of Comptroller,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay certain members of the committee of Ways and Means of the House of Delegates and of the committee on Finance in the Senate of 1864, for labors performed and services rendered after the adjournment of the Legislature, in accordance with the requirements of joint resolution No. 11, assented to March 10th, 1864,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.
