Mr. Tull submitted the following

JOINT RESOLUTION :

Whereas, The General Assembly of Maryland, have learned with regret the failure of the appropriation by Congress, required for the restoration of the Naval Academy of the United States to the city of Annapolis, its original and most appropriate location, whereby difficulties may exist in the execution of the law for that restoration to the great detriment of the public service;

And whereas, The people of this State are much interested in the re-establishment of the naval school at Annapolis, and we, their representatives, are willing to aid the Government of the United States in anticipating the requisite appropriation by Congress at its next session, therefore be it

Resolved, By the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor of this State be and he is hereby authorized to tender to the proper officer of the United States the sum of fifty thousand dollars for the purpose aforesaid, and if the same be accepted, that the Comptroller is hereby authorized and required to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for the said sum of money payable to the proper officer of the United States for the purpose aforesaid as the Governor may direct;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Tull moved to suspend the rules to read the resolution the second time;

Which was decided in the negative.
