For contingent fund for the Adjutant General's office, one thousand dollars;

To Edward Shriver, for services as Judge Advocate, under the late enrollment of Militia, by appointment of the Governor, eight hundred and eighty-eight dollars;

To C. C. Cox, as Surgeon General, under the appointment of the Governor, under the late enrollment of Militia, eight hundred and eighty-eight dollars;

For repairs of roof of Record office building, three hundred dollars;

To the House of Refuge, five thousand dollars;

For the contingent fund of the Land Office, four hundred dollars;

For distributing the Journals of Debates and Proceedings of the State Constitutional Convention to the authorized parties, one hundred and sixty-five dollars;

To be paid upon the proper vouchers for indexing the Laws and Journals of the Senate and House of Delegates for the present session, eight hundred dollars;

For the expense of of distributing statement in reference to the resources of Maryland, including the sum to be paid to Henry Stockbridge for the preparation of the statement, fifteen hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary;

Which was decided in the affirmative.
