Ordered, That the Chief Clerk of the House of Delegates be directed to furnish to the Governor forthwith, a certified copy of the resolution adopted by this House on yesterday, March 23d, 1865, declaring the election of November 8th, 1864, for Judge of the Circuit Court of the 8th Judicial district of this State, a nullity.
