A bill entitled, an Act to make valid the Acts of the Burgess and Commissioners of Middletown, Frederick county, Maryland, in levying a tax to pay the requisition made by General Early upon the citizens of said town in July 1864, and to authorize the collection of the same;

A bill entitled, an Act to amend section 20, Article 4, Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, and to re-enaet the same with amendments,
