General Laws entitled, relating to appeal by parties supposing themselves aggrieved by the action of the Orphans' Courts from the decision of said court to the Circuit Court of the county or to the Superior Court of Baltimore city, and to re-enact the same with amendments, read the first time, 431; read second time, 646; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 712; sent to the Senate, 713.

Reported with amendments, concurred in, read second and by special order third time and passed by yeas and nays, 661, 662; re-considered, amended and passed by yeas and nays, 669; sent to the Senate, 670; returned from Senate with amendments, concurred in, and bill passed by yeas and nays, 736, 737.
