CORPORATIONS—Senate bill to amend Article 26 of the Code of Public General Laws relating to, by adding thereto certain additional sections, providing for the formation of, in the business of obtaining Oil by boring or otherwise, on and upon lands lying within the State, or beyond the limits thereof, read the first time and referred to committee on Corporations, 440; reported without amendment and read the second time, 486; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 740; returned to the Senate, 741.

CORPORATIONS FOR MINING PURPOSES—Senate bill to add to Article 26 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, Corporations, certain sections relative to, read first time and referred to committee on Corporations, 700; reported without amendment and read the second time, 737.

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS—Senate bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 65 of Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws for Baltimore county, entitled, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to amend Article 3 of the Public Local Laws for Baltimore county entitled, "Commissioners," read the first time and referred to the Baltimore county delegation, 221; reported favorably, read the second time, 245; read the third time and passed by yeas and nays, 285, 286; returned to the Senate, 286.
