Leave granted committee on the Judiciary to report a bill to add a new section to Article 28 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to, 293 ; bill reported favorably and read the first time, 457.

Bill reported favorably by committee on the Judiciary to add a new section to Article 28 of the Code of Public General Laws relating to, authorizing them to levy money to pay for re-binding, indexing and transcribing books and dockets of the Register of Wills, and Clerks of the Circuit Courts, read the first time, re-committed to the committee on the Judiciary, 463 ; reported with amendments, concurred in and bill read the second time, 665.

—OF BALTIMORE COUNTY—Leave granted Baltimore county delegation to report a bill authorizing and requiring the, to levy a tax upon the assessable property, to borrow money and pay bounties to volunteers, in order to fill quota of the county, 19.

—OF CALVERT COUNTY—Leave granted Calvert and Charles county delegations to report a bill to make valid the acts of the County Commissioners of Calvert in levying money to pay substitutes for drafted men in said county, 395 ; bill reported favorably and read the first time, 414 ; read second time, 649, 650 ; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 699 ; sent to the Senate, 699.
