Leave granted St. Mary's and Charles county delegations to report a bill changing the terms of the, of Charles county, 292.

Bill reported favorably to amend section 31 of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws, in relation to the, of Charles county, and read the first time, 349; read second time, 550; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 714; sent to the Senate, 714.
