DEEDS TO MAKE VALID—Leave granted committee on the Judiciary to report a bill to make valid all deeds acknowledged without this State before a Justice of the Peace of any other State in which said acknowledgments were made, 153; bill reported favorably and read the first time, 195; recommitted to committee on the Judiciary, 218; reported with amendments and read the second time, 287, 288; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 438, 439; sent to the Senate, 439; returned from the Senate rejected, 634.
