**EATON, WILLIAM P.**—Bill reported favorably by the committee on Claims to compensate, for services rendered the State, as Captain of Company F, 12th Regiment Maryland Volunteer Infantry, and read first time, 395 ; read second time, 630 ; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 684 ; sent to the Senate, 685 ; returned from Senate, passed, 744.

**ELECTIONS**—Leave granted a Select committee to report a bill to repeal section 74 of Article 35, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, 324 ; bill reported favorably, and read the first time, and by special order second time, 327 ; read third time and rejected, 503 ; re-considered and postponed informally, 525 ; passed by yeas and nays, 655 ; sent to the Senate, 666.

Senate bill to repeal sections 29, 30, 32 and 52, of Article 35 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, and to re-enact the same with amendments, read the first time and referred to committee on Elections, 555 ; reported without amendment and read the second time, 737 ; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 747 ; returned to the Senate, 747.

**ELECTIONS, CONTESTED**—Memorial of James L. Ridgely, contesting the seat of Richard Grason, as Judge of the Circuit Court of Baltimore county, 53 ; response of Judge Grason, 118 ; Speaker requested to notify the Governor of the pending contest, and request him to communicate returns of said election to the House, 214 ; two hundred copies of evidence in, ordered to be printed, 333 ; report of majority of committee submitted, 580 ; report of minority, 623 ; report of majority adopted, 675, 676, 677, 678 ; Chief Clerk directed to furnish the Governor with a certified copy of resolutions adopted, 740 ; resolution declaring acts of Richard Grason while acting as Judge, null and void, laid on the table, 742.
