Leave granted Baltimore county delegation to report a bill for re-indexing such records as may require it, and for copying and binding the same in the Clerk's office of said county, 16; bill reported favorably and read the first time, and by special order second and third times, and passed by yeas and nays, 41; sent to the Senate, 42; returned from the Senate with amendments, concurred in, and bill as amended passed by yeas and nays, 80.
