

REGISTRATION OF VOTES—Leave granted a Select committee to report a bill providing for a system of, of this State, 16; bill reported favorably and read the first time, 375; considered and amended, 472 to 483; re-committed, 492; reported with amendments and considered, 531 to 608; read the second time, 609; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 627; sent to the Senate, 627; returned from the Senate, passed, 736; two hundred extra copies ordered to be printed, 408.

REMOVAL OF CAUSES—Bill reported favorably by committee on the Judiciary, to repeal sections 74, 75, 76, 77 and 78 of Article 75 of the Code of Public General Laws, and to enact substitutes therefor, so as to carry out the provisions of the 9th section of Article 4 of the Constitution, relating to the, and read the first time, 289; considered, amended and read the second time, 432, 433; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 564; sent to the Senate, 565; returned from Senate with amendments, concurred in and bill passed by yeas and nays, 673.

REMOVAL OF COUNTY SEATS—See *Repair of Public Buildings*.

RELEASE OF CLAIMS DUE THE STATE—Bill reported favorably by committee on the Judiciary, for the, against Collectors, Sheriffs and others, and to discontinue the suits instituted for the recovery thereof, and read the first time, 460; considered, amended and read the second time, 633; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 688; sent to the Senate, 688; returned from the Senate, passed, 744.

RELIEF OF PARTIES INDEBTED TO THE STATE—Senate bill for the, prior to first day of August, 1860, and certain parties against whom suits have been instituted, &c., read first time and referred to committee on the Judiciary, 495; reported without amendment and read the second time, 529; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 687; returned to the Senate, 688.

REMOVAL OF THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT—Order submitted and rejected for the appointment of a committee of seven to enquire into the propriety and expediency of amending the Constitution so as to allow the seat of Government to be removed from Annapolis, 485.
