Leave granted Committee on the Judiciary to report a bill to add additional sections to Article 93 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, 185; bill reported favorably and read the first time, 317; considered, amended and read the second time, 515, 516; read third time and passed by yeas and nays, 716; sent to the Senate, 717; returned from the Senate, passed, 750.

Leave granted committee on the Judiciary to report a bill to add a section to Article 93 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, 272; bill reported favorably by a minority of the committee and read the first time, 413.

TOBACCO—Senate bill to amend the 26th section of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Lawsⁿ entitled, by declaring and providing that certain tobacco shall not be liable for storage, read first time and referred to the committee on Ways and Means, 79; reported favorably and read second time 89, read third time and rejected by yeas and nays, 31; reconsidered and referred to committee on the Judiciary, 117; reported with amendment and passed by yeas and nays, 126; returned to the Senate, 127.
