VOLUNTEERS—Petition praying the passage of an Act providing a State bounty for, referred to committee on Ways and Means, 14.

Leave granted committee on Ways and Means to report a bill authorizing a State and county bounty for, 44; bill reported favorably, read the first time and by special order second and third times and passed by yeas nays, 56; sent to the Senate, 56; returned from the Senate, with amendments and referred to committee on Ways and Means, 152; reported back and considered, 158 to 177; passed, 177.

Bill reported favorably by committee on Ways and Means to amend the first and second sections of above, and read the first time, 286; considered, amended, read the second and third times and passed by yeas and nays, 328, 329; sent to the Senate, 329.

Senate bill to amend section 1 and 2, as above, read first time and referred to committee on Ways and Means, 321; reported with amendments and read the second time, 396; considered, amended, read the third time and passed by yeas and nays, 411, 412; returned to the Senate, 413; House amendments non-concurred in and committee of conference appointed, 423, 424; report of committee of conference adopted by yeas and nays, 451, 452, 453.

Petition praying an appropriation of a sufficient sum of money to pay the men of the 7th, 9th and 4th regiments United States colored troops the same amount of State bounty that has been paid the 19th, 30th and 39th regiments, referred to committee on Claims, 111; reported back and referred to committee on Ways and Means, 396.

Bill reported favorably by the committee on Ways and Means to report a bill to amend an
