General Orders, No. 35.

Annapolis, Nov. 1st, 1864.

In pursuance of the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled "An act to provide for the organization and discipline of the Militia," passed at January session, 1864, chapter 284, and hereto prefixed, the militia of this State shall be forthwith enrolled and organized as herein provided, and shall be subject to the rules and regulations herein established.

SECT. 1.—The State is hereby divided into fifty-five military districts, as follows, to wit:

MILITARY DISTRICTS.

- SECT. 2.—1. The 1st, 2d, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th election districts of Worcester county shall constitute the first military district.
- 2. The 3d, 4th, 9th and 10th election districts of Worcester county shall constitute the second military district.
- 3. The 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 7th, 9th, 10th and 13th election districts of Somerset county shall constitute the third military district. The bone berband need de donald to vab dand edd
- 4. The 5th, 6th, 8th, 11th, 12th, 14th and 15th election districts of Somerset county shall constitute the fourth military district.
- 5. Dorchester county shall constitute the fifth military district.
- 6. Talbot county shall constitute the sixth military district.
- 7. Caroline county shall constitute the seventh military district.
- 8. Queen Anne's county shall constitute the eighth military district.
- 9. Kent county shall constitute the ninth military district.
- 10. The 1st, 2d, 3d and 5th election districts of Cecil county shall constitute the tenth military district.
