

*Company and Regimental Districts.*

SECT. 3.—Whenever it may become necessary to organize the reserve militia as hereinafter provided, the military districts above mentioned,—which may be then designated the *regimental* districts—may for the purpose of facilitating said organization, be subdivided into as many *company* districts as the commander-in-chief may think necessary, and said military districts, will, unless otherwise ordered, be combined into brigade districts as follows, to wit:

*Brigade Districts.*

SECT.—1. The 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 5th and 6th regimental districts shall constitute the First brigade district. (Worcester, Somerset, Dorchester and Talbot counties.)

2. The 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th regimental districts shall constitute the second brigade district. (Caroline, Kent, Queen Anne's and Cecil counties.)

3. The 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th and 17th regimental districts shall constitute the third brigade district. (Harford and Baltimore counties.)

4. The 18th, 19th, 20th, 21st, 22d, 23d and 24th regimental districts shall constitute the fourth brigade district. (First seven wards of Baltimore city.)

5. The 25th, 26th, 27th, 28th, 29th, 30th and 31st regimental districts shall constitute the fifth brigade district. (Baltimore city, from ward number 8 to number 14 inclusive.)

6. The 32d, 33d, 34th, 35th, 36th and 37th regimental districts shall constitute the sixth brigade district. (Baltimore city, from ward number 15 to number 20 inclusive.)

7. The 38th, 39th, 40th, 41st, 42d and 43d regimental districts shall constitute the seventh brigade district. (Counties of Anne Arundel, Calvert, St. Mary's, Charles, Prince George's, Montgomery and Howard.)

8. The 44th, 45th, 46th, 47th, 48th and 49th regimental districts shall constitute the eighth brigade district. (Counties of Carroll and Frederick.)

9. The 50th, 51st, 52d, 53d, 54th and 55th regimental districts shall constitute the ninth brigade district. (Counties of Washington and Allegany.)

*Division Districts.*

SECT. 5.—Whenever it may be necessary to combine two or more of the foregoing brigade districts with the view of an organization into divisions, the commander-in-chief will make such combinations of said brigade districts for that purpose, as he may consider expedient.
