company may by its by-laws adopt the uniform, a sample of which is deposited in the office of the quartermaster general, and a specification whereof, with the cost, will be furnished by him upon application.

## How provided.

SECT. 59.—Whenever the military fund of any district is sufficiently large to uniform the National Guard organized therein, the said fund may, with the written approval of the quartermaster gneral, and with such conditions as he may prescribe, be appropriated for that purpose by the district commandants, and in case the fund is not adequate to uniform the whole, preference will be given to that company which has first completed its organization.

SECT. 60.—In case any company of the National Guard should hereafter provide itself with a uniform at the private expense of the members thereof, they may upon application to the quartermaster general and with his approval be reimbursed, either in whole or in part, as soon as the condition of the military fund of the district shall warrant.

# Penalty for misuse or abuse of uniform.

SECT. 61.—Any person who shall sell or dispose of any uniform or any part thereof, furnished as herein provided, or who shall wear the same upon any other occasion than when duly authorized by his commander, or who shall wilfully injure or destroy, or refuse to deliver up the same when thereto lawfully ordered shall, on conviction thereof by a court martial, be liable to the same penalty as is hereinbefore provided in section 57, in the case of other public property.

## INSTRUCTION.

SECT. 62.—No other system of instruction in military tactics will be practiced than that published by authority of the War Department of the United States.

#### Books of Tactics.

SECT. 63.—The adjutant general will, from time to time, cause the commanding officers of regiments, battalions and companies, and the district commandants, to be furnished with the standard books of tactics, adapted to their respective arms. The officers so furnished shall give receipts for said books, shall be responsible for their safe keeping, and shall return them to the adjutant general or to such other officer as he may appoint, when required, or deliver them to their successors in office.

SECT. 64.—The members of every company organized in a city district, shall drill once every week for the first month
