

FRIDAY, February 24th, 1865.

Mr. Davis, of Caroline, presented the petition of citizens of Caroline county, relating to Dover's Bridge;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Davis, of Caroline, McNeal and Earle.

On motion of Mr. Jones,

Leave was granted the committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill entitled, an Act to repeal section eighty-two of Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws for Kent county, entitled, "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with an amendment.

Mr. Billingslea, of Carroll, presented the petition of citizens of Carroll county, remonstrating against re-assessment;

Which was read and referred to the committee on that subject.

On motion of Mr. Maund,

Leave was granted the Baltimore City Senators to report a bill entitled, a further supplement to an Act entitled, an Act to incorporate the Baltimore City Passenger Railroad company.

The President appointed Mr. Holton to fill the committees made vacant by Mr. Maclin.

On motion of Mr. Turner,

Leave was granted the committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill entitled, an Act to alter and change the name of Maria Behrens, of Baltimore city, to Henrietta John.

On motion of Mr. Earle,

Ordered, That a Special committee of three be appointed by the Chair to act conjointly with the committee of the House on the subject of encouraging immigration to this State;

The Chair appointed Messrs. Earle, Turner and Maund.

Mr. McNeal presented the memorial of the Maryland and Delaware Railroad company;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Internal Improvements.

Mr. Maund, from a Select committee, reported the bill in favor of the City Passenger Railroad company;
