

“Section 7. And be it further enacted, That the Mayor and City Council of the city of Baltimore, and the County Commissioners of the several counties, be and they are are hereby authorized and directed to raise by loan or otherwise, such sum or sums as may be necessary, to pay to each volunteer or drafted man, or person furnishing a representative substitute, or his authorized agent or attorney, a sum not exceeding two hundred dollars, in addition to the State bounty, as provided for in the previous sections of this act, for the purpose of filling the quotas of the several counties and of the city of Baltimore under the call of the President of the United States, for three hundred thousand men, dated December eighteen hundred and sixty-four, or any other similar one which shall hereafter be made;”

Which was read and rejected.

The bill was then engrossed for a third reading, and
