Leave was granted Messrs. Billingslea, of Carroll, McNeal and Davis, of Caroline, to introduce a bill to repeal article seven (7) of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the Circuit court for Carroll county, and the manner and times of holding the same, with amendments.

On motion of Mr. Maund,

Leave was granted the committee on Judicial Proceedings to report an Act to amend the fifth section of Articls eighteen of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, Clerke of Courts, and to repeal sections thirty-two and thirty-three of Article ten of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, Attachments.
