Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Philpot submitted the following amendment:

Section 17, strike out all after the word "amount" in the 4th line, including line 5, 6, 7, to the word "and" and insert "does not exceed one dollar and fifty cents for each paper restored and recorded according to the provisions of this Act, and is not (in the judgment of the county commissioners) more than a proportional part of the whole work agreed to be done by said commissioner;
