

Mr. Carroll submitted the following amendment :

Amend section one, line twelve, by inserting after the word "may," the words "upon making affidavit before the Judge or Clerk of any Court of Record or the Mayor of any incorporated town celebrating such marriage that he or she is governed by conscientious scruples from having the marriage rites celebrated as hereinbefore provided ;"

Which was read and adopted, and

The bill was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
