Mr. Holton, from a Select committee, reported a bill authorizing the County Commissioners to exempt certain property from taxation;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Ohr, from the committee on Internal Improvements, to which was referred the bill incorporating the Baltimore, Harford and Cecil Railroad company;

Reported it with the following amendment:

Section fourteen, line forty-six, after the word "quantity," amend by striking out the word "of," and insert "or ;"

Which was read and adopted, and

The bill was read the second time.

Mr. Waters, from a Select committee, reported a bill amending the Code of General Laws, relating to crimes and punishments;

Which was read the first time; and

Ordered to be printed.

The bill incorporating the Pocomoke Navigation company, Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
