reported a bill amending the General Laws relating to the running the cars on Sunday;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Earle, from a Select committee, to which was referred the bill relating to a county wharf in Kent county;

Reported it without amendment, and

It was read the second time.

Also, reported without amendment, the bill for the improvement of Fairlee Creek,

And it was read the second time.

Also, reported a bill amending the Code relating to public roads and gates in Kent county;

Which was read the first time, and

Ordered to be printed.

Mr. Maund, from the committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported a bill amending the Code, entitled, chancery;

Which was read the first time, and

Ordered to be printed.

Mr. Carroll, from the committee of Conference, submitted the following

REPORT:

The committee of Conference of the two Houses of the General Assembly, on the difference of opinion on the amendments to the bill entitled, "an Act to amend the first and second sections of the Act passed February eighth, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, at the present session of the General Assembly, entitled, an Act ro provide bounty for soldiers entering the service of the United States to fill the quotas of Maryland under the call of the President of the United States of December eighteen hundred and sixty-four, and under future calls," by leave report the following as agreed upon by said committee of Conference:

The Senate will concur in first, second, third, fourth, fifth and seventh of the amendments proposed by the House. The Senate will also concur in the amendment proposed to the title.

The House will recede from the sixth of its proposed amendments, section three, line thirteen, after the word "sub-district," insert the words "of the county," and will except in lieu thereof the following, in line thirteen of section three, after the word "sub-district," strike out the words "of the county."
