Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Carroll, Ohr and Billingsley, of St. Mary's.

Mr. Carroll from the committee on Corporations reported a bill incorporating the McHenry Oil Company;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Maund from the committee on Judicial Proceedings reported a bill to amend the General Laws relating to embezzlement;

Which was read the first time, and

Ordered to be printed.

Mr. Ohr, from the committee on Elections to which was referred the bill repealing and amending sections 29, 30, 32 and 52, of Article 35, of General Laws relating to elections,

Reported it without amendment, and
