

FRIDAY, March 17th, 1865.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates returned the bill amending the Cumberland Coal and Iron Company, and

The bill to assist S. J. Martenet in the completion of his map;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."

Also, returned the bill repealing and amending the Local Law for Dorchester county.

Endorsed, "rejected by yeas and nays."

Also, delivered the following bills :

A bill in favor of T. S. Alexander and James Revell;

A bill in favor of Henry H. Owings;

A bill in favor of John Sullivan and others;

A bill in favor of James Pritchard and others;

A bill paying the Plaintiff's costs in the case of the State of Maryland vs. the Washington and Baltimore Turnpike Company;

Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill incorporating the town of Templeville, in Caroline and Queen Anne's county;

A bill incorporating the Elk Ridge Landing Bridge Company;

Which were read the first time, and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill repealing sections of Local Law for Somerset county, relating to retailers;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

Mr. Lansdale presented testimony in the case of Graham vs. Waters;

Which was referred to the committee on Elections.

Mr. Tome, from the committee on Finance, to which was referred the bill in favor of the Maryland Hospital,

Reported it with the following amendments :

Amend section 1, line 2, by striking out "twenty-five" and inserting "fifteen."
