

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 146 of the 3d Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the office of the Register of Wills for Baltimore county, and to re-enact the same with amendments;

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal the 10th section of Article 11, of the Code of Public General Laws relating to the oath of Attorneys or other practitioners of law, and to enact a substitute therefor;

A bill entitled, an Act to amend the 32d section of the 17th Article of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the election of commissioners for the town of Centreville in Queen Anne's county,

Severally "endorsed" passed by yeas and nays.
